

**EDraid against
ex-Cong minister,
others in slum
rehabcase**

MUMBAI, MAY 31 /-/- The premises of Congress leader Baba Siddique were today raided by the ED in a money laundering probe related to an alleged Rs 400-crore slum rehabilitation irregularities case. Officials said the searches were conducted at about seven locations in Maharashtra capital, including premises of Siddique, a real estate firm and a builder connected to him. Siddique, a former minister in Maharashtra government, is known for his links with Bollywood celebrities and drug superstars Salman Khan and Shah Rukh Khan into a much talked about drug hub in 2013, after years of reported frosty relations. Some front companies allegedly "connected to" Siddique were also searched. The Enforcement Directorate (ED) teams, which swooped down on these premises early morning, the ED said, has registered criminal cases against Siddique and about a dozen others under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) recently, based on a local police FIR. The Bandra police had registered an FIR in 2014, on directions of a local court, to probe alleged financial irregularities in a slum rehabilitation project launched in suburban Bandra where Siddique is alleged to have been involved. Siddique has been the Chairman of the Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority (MHADA) between 2000-2004. A complainant had approached a local court in 2012 stating that the plots allotted in the residential buildings constructed after demolishing the slum in the Bandra area were granted on the basis of alleged fake documents and had other irregularities. The agency also suspects use of certain 'front' or 'benami' companies in committing the alleged irregularities and hence the searches are being conducted to gather more evidence, they said. The ex-minister had denied allegations made against him in this case in the past. Siddique has been a part-time Congress MLA, Minister of State for food and Civil Supplies (during 2004-08) in the Maharashtra government and has also served as a Municipal Corporator. His grand Ifaar parties are attended by a host of Bollywood celebrities. His 2013 party is remembered for actor Salman Khan and Shah Rukh Khan embracing each other, hinting a thaw in their ties.(PTI)

**HC seeks reply
of BCI, DU on
plea over seats
in LLB course**

NEW DELHI, MAY 31 /-/- The Delhi High Court today sought the responses of the Centre, the Bar Council of India (BCI) and the Delhi University (DU) on a plea against reducing the number of seats in the LLB course at the university. Acting Chief Justice Gita Mittal and Justice C Hari Shankar posted the matter for further hearing on June 5. The plea filed by advocate Joginder Kumar Sukhija said a large number of students will be affected if the seats for the course at the varsity were reduced and infringe their legal and fundamental right to higher education of their choice. According to the decision taken by the BCI and the DU Law Faculty the university will only admit 1,400 students to its LLB course from the academic year 2017-2018. The faculty has been catering 2,310 students for over four decades. The plea also said that by reducing the seats, public money, which is used to provide grant to the optical use. "The varsity is a public funded educational institution receiving grants from University Grants Commission, and by reducing number of admissions, the public money is not put to optimum use."

**Ruckus in Delhi Assembly; AAP
leaders manhandle sacked minister**

NEW DELHI, MAY 31 /-/- High drama prevailed at the Delhi Assembly today when a few AAP MLAs and sacked minister Kapil Mishra came to blows as the latter held out a banner with allegations of corruption against Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal. Party MLAs, including Madan Lal, Jarnail Singh, were seen lunging at Mishra and dragging him as he raised a poster referring to the allegations, before Speaker Ram Niwas Goel ordered him to be marshalled out of the House. Later, Goel adjourned the House, which was convened to pass the GST bill, for 15 minutes. "I was not allowed to speak. The moment I attempted to speak, four to five AAP MLAs started hitting me. It's perhaps for the first time that MLAs have been used to muffle a dissenting voice inside the House," Mishra told reporters. Mishra also alleged deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia was behind the entire episode, saying the MLAs rushed towards him after he "prompted" them to do so.

Delhi Assembly Speaker Ram Niwas Goel today criticised the AAP MLAs involved in heckling sacked minister Kapil Mishra inside the House, saying the incident was "deeply disturbing". The speaker said he will "look into the matter" while talking Mishra over his demands in a special session convened at the Ramliha Maidan here over allegations of corruption against Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Health Minister Satyendra Jain. "Whatever happened today inside the Delhi Assembly is unfortunate. I am deeply disturbed with the incident. Whatever they (AAP MLAs) did was wrong. The MLAs should not have left their seats," he told reporters. Earlier, the House witnessed unruly scenes as Mishra was pushed and dragged by a few AAP MLAs after he unfurled a banner de-

**DMK stages protest against
cattle slaughter ban**

CHENNAI, MAY 31 /-/- The DMK today came down strongly on the BJP-led central government over the ban on sale of cattle for slaughter, saying a situation has arisen where "we should eat only what the prime minister desires". Leading DMK protest president MK Stalin also warned of "another Marina revolution" (on the lines of pro-jailikattai stir) if the recent notification on the matter was not withdrawn. Accusing the Centre of coming up with such notifications to cover up its three years of "non-performance", he also questioned the "silence" of Tamil Nadu Chief Minister K Palaniswami on the issue. Recalling various promises made by the BJP in the 2014 Lok Sabha polls, Stalin said none of them, including ones about retrieving black money and creating jobs, had been fulfilled. "So, this ban, what we eat is now being restricted. A situation has come up where we should eat only what (Prime Minister Narendra) Modi desires. The civil liberties guaranteed by the Constitution are being snatched. Freedom is being snatched," he claimed. He alleged that the Modi government was coming up with such notifications to divert people's attention from issues plaguing the country. Three years of BJP rule have passed. There are no schemes or achievements that benefit people. To cover that up and divert the attention of people, the BJP (government) is making such laws," he said. He wondered if the central government had "deposited at least Rs 15 or Rs 15 lakh" in the bank account of each citizen as promised by Modi in 2014 under his efforts to retrieve the black money stashed in foreign havens. He questioned why Palaniswami had not responded although his counterparts in Kerala and West Bengal have opposed the ban on sale of cattle for slaughter. Palaniswami had on May 27 said he would comment on the Centre's ban on cattle slaughter going through the notification. The DMK leader said though the BJP had given importance to cooperative federalism during the 2014 polls, it has now reduced states to "municipalities" and chief ministers to "municipal chiefs.(PTI)

**Emergency landing by army
chopper in field, no one hurt**

JAIPUR, MAY 31 /-/- Bad weather today forced an Army helicopter to make an emergency landing in an open field along the Jaipur-Agra national highway in this district but no one was hurt. A senior Army officer and two pilots were on board the helicopter when it made the emergency landing at around noon, police said. The helicopter was on its way from Jhansi in Uttar Pradesh to Sangarner airport in Jaipur. "Due to bad weather, the pilots had to make emergency landing in an open field close to Jaipur. Agra national highway at around 12 noon," SHO of Kanota Police station Gaurishankar told PTI. Moments after the safe landing, the senior officer left by road. The helicopter took off for Jaipur when the weather conditions became favourable for flying after more than one hour, the police said. **Minor girl raped by
two becomes pregnant,
case registered**

MUZAFFARNAGAR, MAY 31 /-/- A 16-year-old girl, who was allegedly raped repeatedly and warned against making a complaint, became pregnant after which the police here have registered a case against two youth. According to the police, the incident came to light after the parents of the teenager came to know that she was three-months pregnant. Following a complaint by the girl's father, a case has been registered at the Kotwali police station. According to circle officer Tejvir Singh, the case was registered under IPC sections dealing with rape, criminal intimidation and also the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act against two youths named Bilal and Meherban. The two accused are absconding, Singh said. In the complaint, the girl's father has alleged that his daughter was gang-raped by the accused persons for five months. The complaint also said that the girl was threatened with dire consequences if she disclosed the crime to anyone, police officials said. Meanwhile, security has been tightened and extra police personnel have been deployed in the village as a precautionary measure. (PTI)

**Shah conducts door to door
campaign to woo tribals in Gujarat**

DEVALIYA (GUJ), MAY 31 /-/- Seeking the support of tribal population in poll-bound Gujarat, BJP chief Amit Shah today held door to door campaign in this remote village of Chhotu Udaipur district. He also addressed a booth-level party workers meeting and had lunch with a tribal family as part of Gujarat BJP's "Vistarak" initiative, which aims at establishing direct contact with people at booth-level through door-to-door visits. Shah along with Gujarat BJP in-charge Bhupendra Yadav and state party leaders went from door to door seeking votes for the saffron party in this village in central Gujarat. The eastern Gujarat tribal belt, despite serious efforts of BJP, is dominated by Congress, which had in 2012 elections managed to win 16 to 17 seats out of the 28 assembly segments. Shah and his team campaigned in Devaliya village under Chhotu Udaipur constituency, which has been held by eight-time Congress MLA Mohansinh Rathwa. In a brief address to the newly induced booth-level party workers from Devaliya village, Shah said while Gujarat remains the party's strong fortress, they have to make it further strong and ensure that it continues to remain strong.
