Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying quarterly and year to date financial results of ANTARCTICA LIMITED ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022 attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit/(loss) and other comprehensive income/ loss and other financial information for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022.

Basis of Opinion

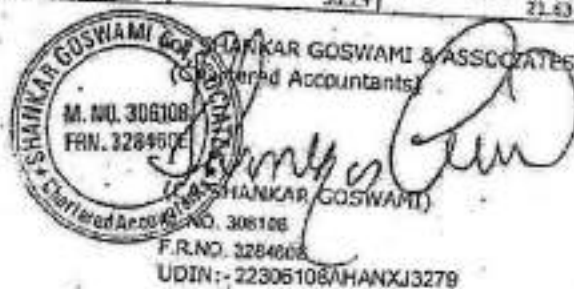
